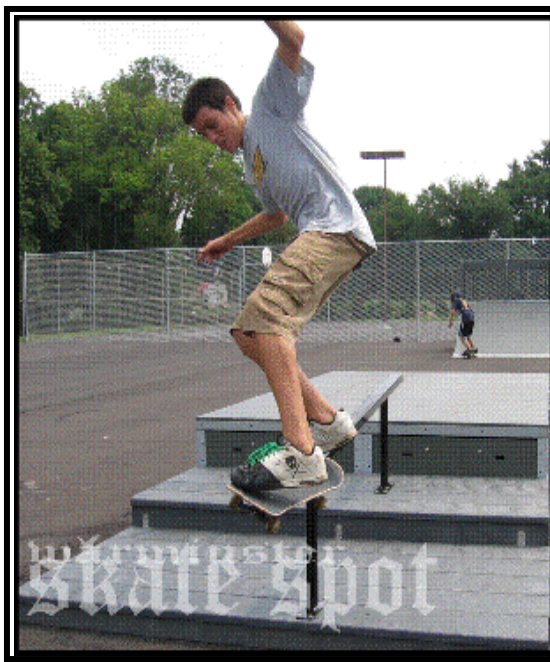

In early 2007, an active group of parents and teens formed the Warminster Skate Club (WSC) in hopes of kick-starting a project that had been 10 years in the making – the development of a **free** skateboard/bmx/rollerblade park for youth of the Warminster community. With sponsorship dollars from area businesses and funding from the Parks & Recreation Department, they were able to begin construction of the Warminster Skate Spot at Munro Park with some fundamental pieces of equipment. A “community build” was held in July, followed by the Grand Opening and special dedication of the skate park to Kyle Quinn in September of 2007. The group continues to raise funds for additional pieces of modular equipment.

In 2008, The Warminster Skate Club (WSC) received permission from the Warminster Park, Recreation & Conservation Board, the Township Supervisors and the Zoning Hearing Board to allow local businesses the opportunity to advertise on the fencing surrounding the heavily used Skate Spot at Munro Park. The opportunity to advertise your business locally, at a very affordable rate while also supporting the youth of our community, has been very well received. All of the proceeds are put back into the program to cover maintenance and equipment improvements. We are offering businesses 3'X5' billboard space to be placed on the upper perimeter fences that surround the Skate Spot at Munro Park.

In 2011, the Quinn Family expanded support of the skate park by teaming up with the Friends of Warminster Parks, a 501-c-3 non-profit organization that promotes the development of the Warminster Park system. Together they hope to raise more funds to continue the growth of the Skate Spot and add new modular pieces. Area businesses are encouraged to sponsor pieces of equipment, make donations, and even start corporate “giving” campaigns to assist with this project.
